The State Street Mural Project is a community arts project sponsored by Great West Institute. A dozen local artists will be selected to collaborate with local childrens classes and community groups to design and create each of the twelve sections (180 linear feet of wall space) on Baxter's Cafe. We will help facilitate the collaboration and design process.
